Year in Review (2023)

2023 marked a significant year for Handaruan Institute as we launched several pilot projects to achieve our goals.

- Collaboration with Food Bank of Indonesia: We partnered with the Food Bank of Indonesia on the "Mentari Bangsaku" program. This project provided assistance and served as a learning experience for UPNVJT students involved in promoting SDGs and taking action.
- Online Training on Data Writing: In collaboration with LABIRIN (UPNVJT's International Relations Laboratory), we conducted an online training program on "Data Writing."

UPNVJT students from the International Relations Department supported our activities, particularly the Mentari Bangsaku program. This collaboration fostered knowledge sharing and practical experience for the students.

Looking Ahead (2024)

- Handaruan Youth Conference: This conference aims to create a learning-sharing platform among students.
- Handaruan Writing Center: This center will provide resources and support student writing journeys.

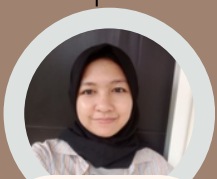

Mentari Bangsaku

Mentari Bangsaku is a collaborative project initiated by the Handaruan Institute and Labirin UPN Veteran East Java in partnership with the Foodbank of Indonesia. This project aims to participate in four SDG programs, which are zero hunger, good health and well-being, sustainable cities and communities, and responsible consumption and production.

The program took place on November 21-22, 2023, in Surabaya, the second largest city in Indonesia. The city's rapid urban population growth has created potential for food waste, which is a problem that this program aims to address. The program involved active students from the Laboratorium of the International Relations Department, also known as The LABIRIN FOUNDATION Team from UPNVJT, who participated as part of the outreach team.



Project Goals:

- To improve the nutritional knowledge of children and parents in Surabaya
- To reduce food waste in Surabaya
- To raise awareness of the importance of sustainable consumption and production

Project Activities:

- Nutrition education for children and parents
- Food distribution to underprivileged families
- Educational games on food waste sorting
- Talkshow on sustainable consumption and production

Project Impact:

- Increased knowledge of nutrition among children and parents
- Reduced food waste in Surabaya
- Increased awareness of the importance of sustainable consumption and production

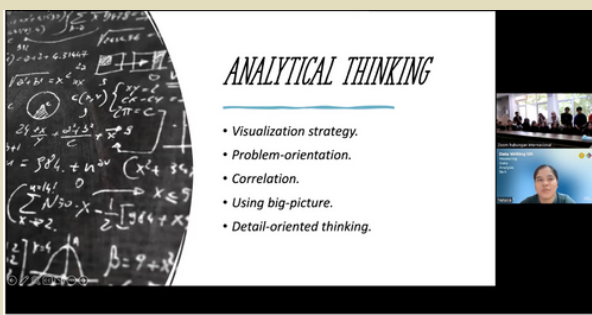
The Mentari Bangsaku project is expected to be a pilot project for a collaboration between undergraduate students & small-scale local NGOs in other cities in Indonesia.

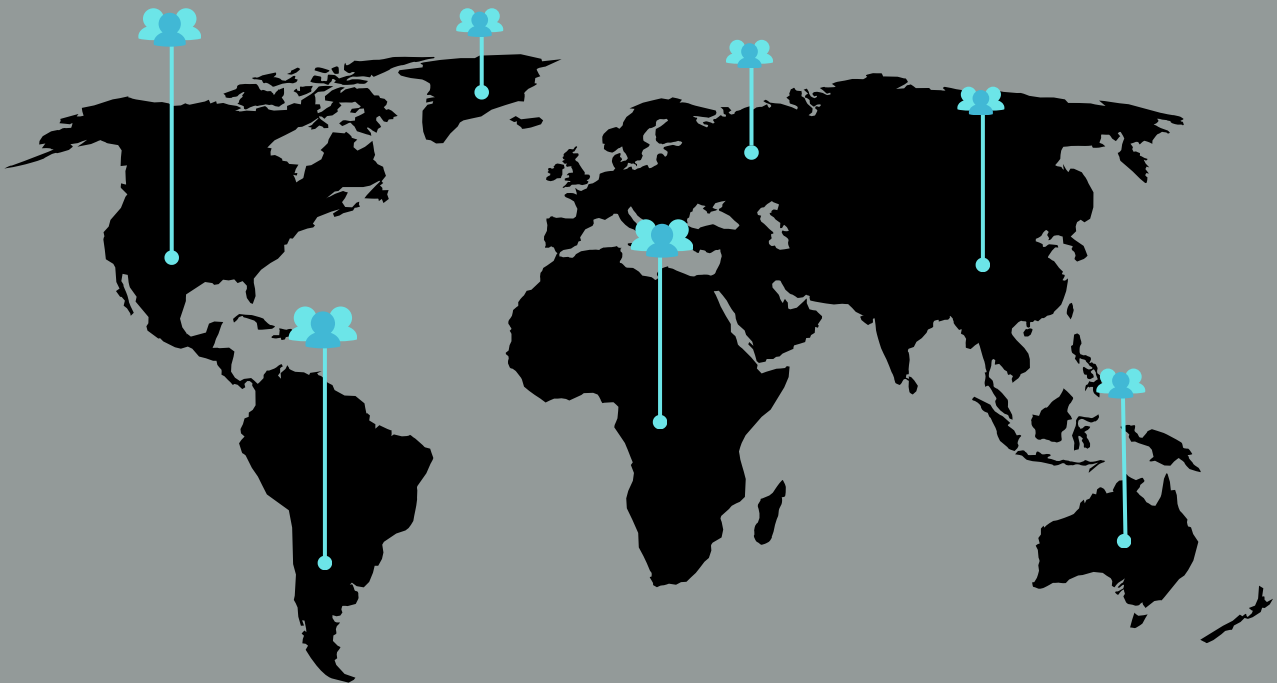
